What: Tobay Beach Dune Stabilization Project

When: Saturday March 20, 2010 at 10am
(rain or shine-dress appropriately)

Where: Tobay Beach in Massapequa on Ocean Parkway east of Jones Beach, off Wantagh Parkway

Park in lot located on north side of parkway, then walk to the ocean side and sign in at the table (ask for LIFun4Kids.com and you will be directed to our assigned sand dune)

Why: Dune grass reduces erosion and benefits local wildlife...the grass helps stabilize and enlarge the dunes by catching blowing and drifting sand, providing a natural barrier against storms and high winds

How: Plant grasses with shovels provided by the Town of Oyster Bay

Cost: **FREE**

Local generous donors will provide coffee, hot chocolate, clam chowder and donuts to all volunteers.
